We are happy to report another successful year of the safety program. Our 2016-2017 workers compensation insurance year closed on February 28<sup>th</sup> 2017. During this period HCS had over 160,000 man hours worked with two recorded injuries. Both injuries were lacerations that occurred from falling objects. These employees were treated with minor medical attention and missed a minimal amount of work.

As part of our continued effort to keep our employees safe we have addressed ways to avoid injuries from falling objects. We have made a point to discuss this hazard during our safety committee meetings as well as covering in our safety updates and toolbox talks. The bottom line is we always need to be aware of our surroundings!
