#### **2017 SAFETY PROGRAM IN REVIEW**

We are happy to report another successful year of the safety program. Our 2017-2018 workers compensation insurance year will close at the end of February. During this period HCS had over 160,000 man hours worked with no missed time on our workers comp policy due to injury.

We did see an uptick in the number of injuries recorded from the year before. Fortunately all were minor injuries where the employee was able to quickly return to work. Over the last year we had four injuries of cuts to hand/arm. Lacerations are one of our biggest on the job hazards. Ensure that you are ALWAYS wearing appropriate safety equipment, i.e. safety gloves, protective sleeves. If you ever need safety equipment please request from your supervisor.

As part of our continued commitment to your safety, we will be conducting First Aid and CPR classes for supervisors in March. These classes will help ensure that we are properly trained to assist our employees should they become injured. It is extremely important to us that you return home from work each and every day healthy.
